The candidates having Paramedical Diploma Course (PMB) qualification & have applied against Notification of B.Sc (Allied Health Sciences) have to apply afresh against this course. The fees paid earlier will be refunded.

Please note that the candidate will not become eligible for selection of seat for the course only by **ONLINE REGISTRATION**.

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1. Introduction

Government of Karnataka in its GO No.HFW 334 RGU 2018, Bangalore dated 12-10-2018, has authorized Karnataka Examination Authority as an agency for selection of candidates for admission to B.Sc Allied Health Sciences course for the seats in Government colleges. Henceforth, the rules and regulations framed by the committee for the selection of candidates for admission to the above courses in accordance with Government Order and subsequent amendments, revised rules if any as on the date of admission will apply.

2. Academic Eligibility for Government seats B.Sc Allied Health Sciences course (LATERAL ENTRY)

A candidate seeking admission to the Bachelor of Science Degree Courses in the Allied Health Sciences course from SlNo.1 to 7 shall have studied English as one of the Principal subject during the tenure of the course and for those seeking admission to Bachelor of Science Degree Courses shall have the following eligibility:

1. Eligibility for admission to lateral Entry to the Allied Health Sciences courses shall have passed Diploma in the concerned subject to which he/she is seeking lateral entry.

The Lateral entry scheme eligibility criteria for the B.Sc. Allied Health Science courses shall be as follows:

- 1. **B.Sc. Anesthesia Technology:** Diploma in Anesthesia Technology from a Government recognized Institution where in the examinations are being conducted by the Government Board which offers the diploma.
- 2. **B.Sc. Respiratory Care Technology:** Diploma in Respiratory Care Technology or equivalent from a Government recognized institution where in the examinations are being conducted by the Government Board which offers the diploma.
- 3. **B.Sc. Operation Theatre Technology:** Diploma in Operation Theatre Technology or equivalent from a Government recognized institution where in the examinations are being conducted by the Government Board which offers the diploma.

- 4. **B.Sc. Renal Dialysis Technology:** Diploma in Renal Dialysis Technology from a Government recognized institution where in the examinations are being conducted by the Government Board which offers the diploma.
- 5. **B.Sc. Medical Lab Technology:** Diploma in Medical Lab Technology from a Government recognized institution where in the examinations are being conducted by the Government Board which offers the diploma.
- 6. **B.Sc. Medical Imaging technology:** Diploma in Radiography or equivalent from a Government recognized institution where in the examinations are being conducted by the Government Board which offers the diploma.
- 7. **B.Sc. Medical Radiotherapy:** Diploma in Radiography or equivalent from a Government recognized institution where in the examinations are being conducted by the Government Board which offers the diploma.

3. Certificates to be produced at the Time of Document Verification

1.	S.S.L.C marks card (for proof of Date of Birth).	
2.	Diploma marks card of all Semesters	
3.	Prescribed certificates in the case of candidates claiming reservation under different categories i.e., category & income certificate issued by the Tahashildar of Karnataka only.	
4.	Domicile Certificate for 10 years in Karnataka (Issued by the Tahashildar of Karnataka) or Study Certificate of seven years in Karnataka.	
5.	Certificate claiming reservation under article 371-J issued by the Assistant Commissioner of Revenue Department.	
6.	Attested Photo Copy Transfer Certificate.	

6.Guidelines to fill the online Application form:

Note: Since the Applicant should upload their photographs in online application entry, the applicant should scan their passport size photograph (Snapped after 01/04/2018 with Name & Date on the photograph) in .jpg format and make available for uploading with the following specifications.

Width = 1.3 inches, Height = 1.6 inches, Resolution = 200 X 200 dpi and the file size should be less than 100kb.

Select the Course -B.Sc Allied Health Sciences(Lateral Entry)

- 1. Name of the Candidate: Fill the name in **BLOCK LETTERS** as per 10th standard Marks Card.
- 2. Mother's Name: Mother's name in full should be filled.
- 3. **Father's Name:** Father's Name should correspond to the form and spelling in the 10th standard Marks Card.
- 4. **Date of Birth:** The Date of Birth should correspond to the entry in the 10th Marks Card in dd/mm/yyyy.
- 5. Place of Birth: Select the District in which you were born.
- 6. **Gender:** Select from the drop down list Female /Male.

- 7. **Nationality:** Enter the Nationality.
- 8. Qualifying Examination: Paramedical Diploma
- 9. Marks obtained in Diploma of all the three years: Marks secured by the candidate
- 10. Domicile of Karnataka: Select form the drop down list Yes/No.
- 11. **Category:** Selective the respective category and enclose the certificate obtained from the Tahashildar of Karnataka

After filling the online application form press **SUBMIT** button, **if you are sure that all the data entered by you is correct**. The system will ask for uploading photograph and the scanned photograph of .jpg format file with the above mentioned specification has to be uploaded. An Application Number will get generated and please record it for your future usage. Take the printout of the filled-in application.

NOTE: The application may be edited any number of times before declaration and final submit. Once application is submitted and declared editing of application form is not possible only payment and final printout is enabled.

The Course wise merit list will be announced on the KEA website as per calendar of events.
