NOTIFICATION

Sub: Publication of intake and seat matrix of B.Sc. Nursing, BPT & BPO Courses in Government and Private Nursing, Physiotherapy and Prosthetic & Orthotics Colleges, during the academic year 2018-19.

Ref: Letter No. DME/NRC(1)/02/2018-19, dated 27.07.2018 from the Director of Medical Education, Bangalore.

The Karnataka Selection of candidates for admission to Nursing, Pharmacy and Physiotherapy courses Rules, 2003 have been promulgated by the Government of Karnataka in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 145 (1) of the Karnataka Education Act, 1983 and section 14 of the Karnataka Educational Institutions (prohibition of capitation fee) Act, 1984. These rules have come into force from 03-07-2003, the date on which they were published in the Karnataka Gazette under Notification No. HFW 44 MPS 2003 (2), dated 03.07.2003 and applicable from the academic session 2003-04 regulating the manner of admission to the aforesaid Nursing, Pharmacy and Physiotherapy courses and the structure of fee chargeable from the students seeking admission to such courses.

- 2) The Karnataka Selection of the Candidates for admission to Nursing, Pharmacy and Physiotherapy Courses (Amendment) Rules 2003, have been enacted which came in to force from 12-11-2003, the date on which they were published in the Karnataka Gazette under Notification No. HFW 179 PTD 2005, dated 19-04-2007 amending the seat sharing ratio to 20:80 between the Government and the Management.
- Under section 45 (10) (b) of RGUHS Act, 1994 the intake in respect of cach of the B. Sc. Nursing, BPT and BPO will have to be determined and the total number of seats under Government seat category for admission to such courses both in Government and in private Colleges shall be notified by Government from time to time.
 - 4) The Government of Karnataka under rule 7 and 9 of the Karnataka Selection of candidates for admission to Nursing, Pharmacy and Physiotherapy courses Rules, 2003, read with section 45 (10) (b) of the RGUHS Act, 1994 hereby notifies particulars of the courses and reservation of seats for the SCs / STs / OBCs and other special categories as applicable for the academic session 2018-19 as specified in the Annexure I to IX appended to this notification.

5) The fee structure chargeable to the candidates seeking admission to B.Sc. Nursing, BPT & BPO courses under Government Quota in the current academic year 2018-19 shall be same as were in the previous academic year i.e. 2017-18 which is as follows:

- The Committee constituted by the Government in its Order No. 1IFW 361 MPS 2006, dated 19-08-2006 shall conduct the counselling for allotment to the 1st year B. Sc Nursing, BPT and BPO courses in Government Colleges and Government seats in Private Nursing, Physiotherapy and allied Science Colleges for the academic year 2018-19.
- 7) The Selection of candidates for allotment to 1st year B. Sc Nursing, BPT and BPO courses shall be strictly in conformity with the provisions contained in the Karnataka Selection of candidates for admission to Nursing, Pharmacy and Physiotherapy courses, Rules, 2003.
