Combined Centralised Counselling for Admission to MBBS and BDS courses for the year 2017-18 in the state of Karnataka

Government in their letter No. HFW 124 RGU Bangalore, dated 28-06-2017, have directed KEA to conduct Common Counselling for admission to UG Medical and Dental courses for all Government, Private (including Minority), NRI and Others seats for the year 2017-18 in the state of Karnataka.

Accordingly, KEA is inviting application online from the eligible, qualified in NEET-2017 candidates from all over India, for admission to UG Medical and Dental courses for the year 2017-18 in the state of Karnataka. The candidates who have scored more than or equal to the prescribed minimum score in NEET-2017 only are eligible to register for UG Admissions. Please note that SC/ST/OBC eligibility criteria are applicable to SC/ST/OBC Karnataka candidates only.

The interested eligible candidates have to register online from 5.00 pm on 05-07-2017 to 09-07-2017 up to 5.30 pm by visiting KEAWebsite.

The declaration of NEET- 2017 result and Admission is subject to the Special Leave Petitions Nos. 16307/17, 16311/17 and 17447/1/2017 as directed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its decision dated 12-06-2017. The result of the candidates above 25 years of age is also subject to the outcome of Writ Petition pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in this regard.
